WHAT TO BRING TO CAMP

We discourage campers from buying any new clothing for camp. Just have them wear what needs to be worn out (or lost). Please clearly label ALL possessions, even items such as flashlights, sleeping bags, boots, canteens, hats, etc. A cap or hat is important, as the sun is hot here in the mountains. We do not have laundry facilities on the ranch. In emergencies, laundry can be taken to town.

The number of items listed below are for a two week session and should be adjusted depending on the length of the camper's camp session. All camp schedules include at least one over night campout so sleeping bags are a necessity. Do not bring items of any value such as expensive cameras, cell phones, jewelry, electronic equipment, or activity equipment. Prude Ranch will provide all equipment necessary for activity classes.

Check in Process: We will be conducting a "Drive Through" Check in. We will stagger check in times alphabetically.

Parents will not even need to get out of the car. The first stop will be with the nurses who will be taking temperature as you come through the gate. This is where you will turn in the Pre-Camp Temperature and Activity Log, the signed waiver for Covid 19, and any other missing paperwork. The nurses will complete their screening process. Once camper is cleared, parents will drive through the next 3 stations, Camp Bank, Mail Drop, and Luggage Drop Off. We are really counting on our camp families to help keep our Prude Ranch bubble safe.

End Of Camp Activities: We are TENTIVELY going to try and put on rodeos for parents beginning the final Saturday of camp at 8:30 AM. Girl Campers will be first followed by Boy Campers and then Cityslickers or Advanced Campers. We will have campers packed up and ready and once their rodeo and small awards program is over, they are free to check out of camp. Counselors will have an end of camp packet to give you. Once Loaded, the nurses will have a station to pick up Medications. An Evaluation Form will be emailed for you to give us Feedback.

Parents will be notified immediately in case of any camp emergency.

Pocket Change for Campers: We recommend depositing no more than \$15 cash (in small bills) per week in the CAMP BANK to be used in Granny's Closet.
